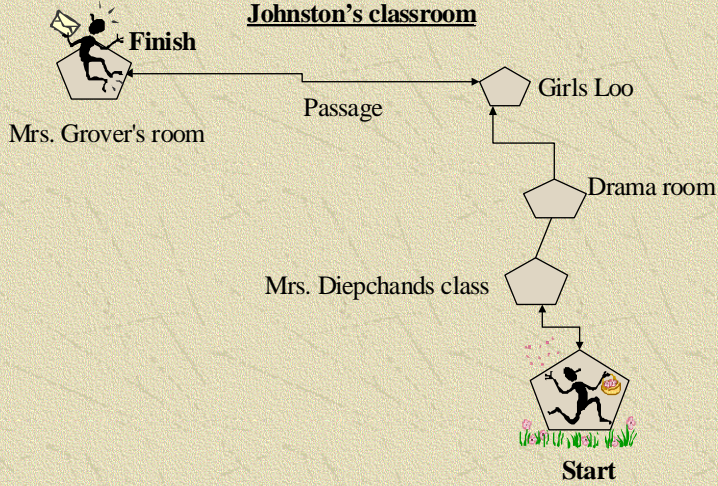

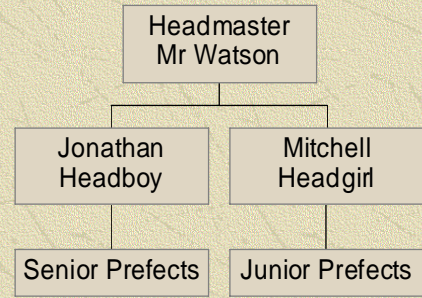

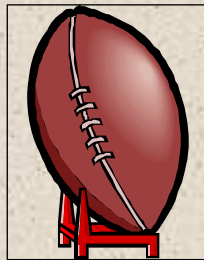
Organizational Chart

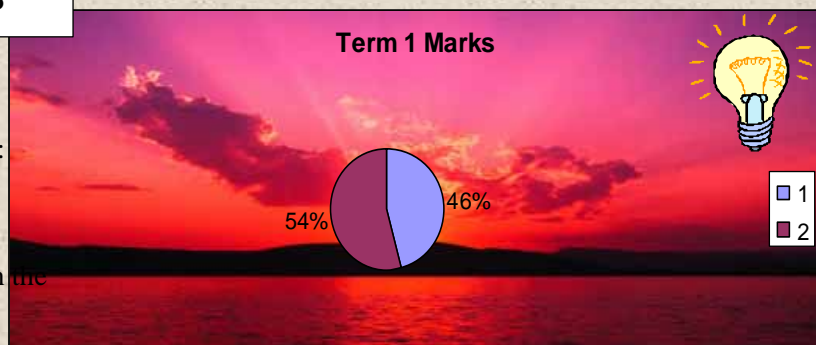
With the new range of laptops teachers are able to plan lesson properly, as well as the help of the smart board the learners are able to engage with the lesson much better.
